

Clinical Visits in 2022 In-Person & Telehealth

In November of 2022 our leadership team formalized our strategic improvement plan to revitalize the health center through the lens of enduring stability. We call this highly collaborative plan *Better Together*. The plan brought together FHCW staff members throughout the organization, strategic partners, and local leaders. This successful endeavor would conclude in early 2023.



Throughout the year, we served over 32,000 individuals in 77 languages through 131,812 clinical visits, providing medical, dental, mental health, and social services. Additionally, we offered over 41,000 nutrition visits for low-income clients, prenatal care for 441 expectant mothers, and infant care for 373 babies.






